






#### Benefits of Education

What There are three types of financial aid available to most students:

- grants and scholarships (financial aid you don't repay)
- loans (financial aid you must repay)
- work-study and community or military service (financial aid you earn)

Most students receive a financial aid package put together by the school you plan to attend. It may include all three types of aid.

Who Every student admitted to Anoka-Ramsey Community College who meets the basic eligibility criteria and completes the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is eligible for some form of assistance.

Why Financial aid is intended to fill the gap between the actual price of the school and what students and their families can realistically contribute.

Financial aid is often based on financial need. But to receive any grants, loans or work-study assistance, you need to fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To begin your application, visit: fafsa.ed.gov.

#### **Anoka-Ramsey Community College Scholarships**

Anoka-Ramsey's campus foundations offer more than 80 scholarships. In 2011-2012, 114 Cambridge Campus students received more than \$74,000 in foundation scholarships. Approximately 134 Coon Rapids Campus students received more than \$131,000 in foundation scholarships including two Presidential Start scholarships which pay for full tuition, fees and books.
