
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Welcome Letter



Refund requests for a single-session class, program, or activity must be made 48 hours prior to the class session. A \$5 administrative fee will be deducted from the original amount paid by the participant.


Waukee Community Education reserves the right to cancel classes if there is insufficient enrollment. Should that occur, full refunds will be given.
