PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Pharmacy Technicians assist licensed pharmacists in providing health care and medications to patients. As a Pharmacy Technician, you must have broad knowledge of pharmacy practice and be skilled in the techniques required to order, stock, package, and prepare medications but don't need the advanced college education required of a licensed pharmacist. You could work in a hospital, retail setting, home health



care, nursing home, clinic, or mail order. MEDICAL ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT

Do you want to play an instrumental role ensuring the efficient operation of a hospital unit or medical office by performing administrative and clerical tasks such as maintaining medical records, scheduling appointments and medical tests, keeping supplies stocked, and communicating with other health care professionals, patients, and visitors? If you answered "yes," then a career as a



Medical Administrative Assistant is perfect for you. As a Medical Administrative Assistant you will be a member of the supporting cast that helps maintain a healthcare facility's service and performance. You may also perform other duties such as routine and regulatory checks, patient placement and transfers, and specimen labeling. You will typically work under the supervision of the registered nursing staff or the health information administrator. One of the main responsibilities of this role is to act as a liaison between the patients and staff. MATH CALCULATIONS FOR PHARMACY TECHNICIANS

The Math Calculations for Pharmacy Technicians program will help you master the mathematical calculations necessary to become a Certified Pharmacy Technician and calculate drug dosages safely and accurately. Patient safety depends on the ability of healthcare professionals, especially those responsible for distribution of medication, to calculate medication dosages and doses. This program covers everything from basic math skills to reading and interpreting labels and physicians' orders, as well as introducing you to key calculation and conversion concepts. Other vital topics include conversions between the various measurement systems, reconstituting liquid medications, and calculating medications based on a patient's age or body weight. You will learn calculation skills and competencies needed by pharmacy technicians through step-by-step examples and proven ways to make it easy to learn and remember how to do equations using formulas.

As a Pharmacy Technician, you must learn this skill early in your studies and use it continuously throughout your career. This program is intended to provide the basic – and not so basic – mathematical concepts that are applied to pharmacy. You will be provided with the knowledge you need to preform calculations for dispensing or administering medications in ambulatory care and inpatient arenas as well as basic accounting procedures used in retail and some hospital pharmacies. Traditional methods of calculation as well as other unique ways of obtaining correct calculations will be taught.

Successful completion of this program will waive your Math prerequisite for the Pharmacy Technician CHG-3001 program.





INTRODUCTION TO GIS

What is geographic information system (GIS) and how is it used to create and interact with maps and data sources? This powerful computer system can be used to create "smart" maps and provide robust analytical tools as a means of solving problems and answering questions related to location-related data and information. It is used for countless different applications for everything from disaster management to market research analysis. GIS is a well-established technology in a rapidly growing field referred to as geospatial technologies, which encompasses many types of methods and techniques for the collection, analysis, modeling, and visualization of geospatial data.

GIS skills are in demand for jobs related to engineering, planning, utilities, management, transport/logistics, insurance, telecommunications, natural resources and business. For that reason, GIS and location intelligence applications can be the foundation for many location-enabled services that rely on analysis and visualization.

GIS applications are tools that allow you to create interactive queries (user-created searches), analyze spatial information, edit data in maps, and present the results of all these operations. This session will include discussion of basic concepts of GIS along with hands-on exercises using ESRI's ArcGIS software. 


