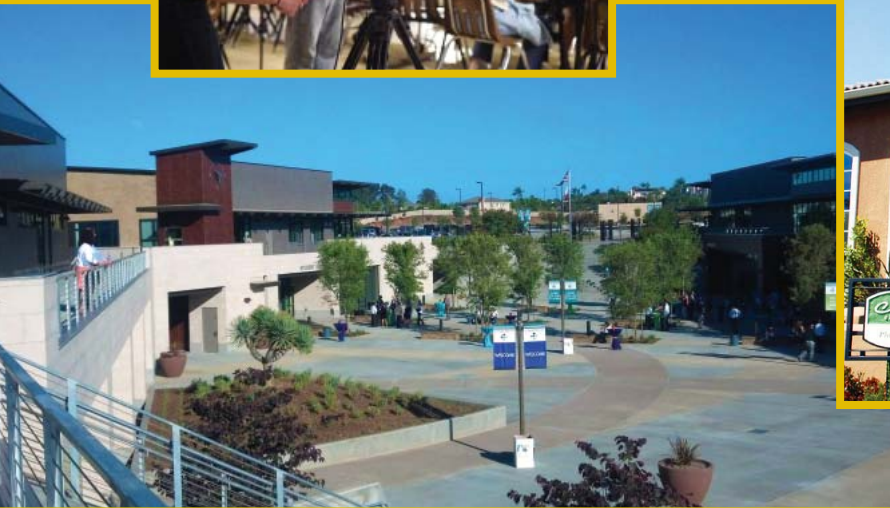

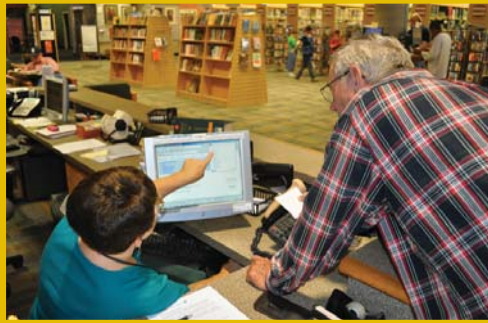

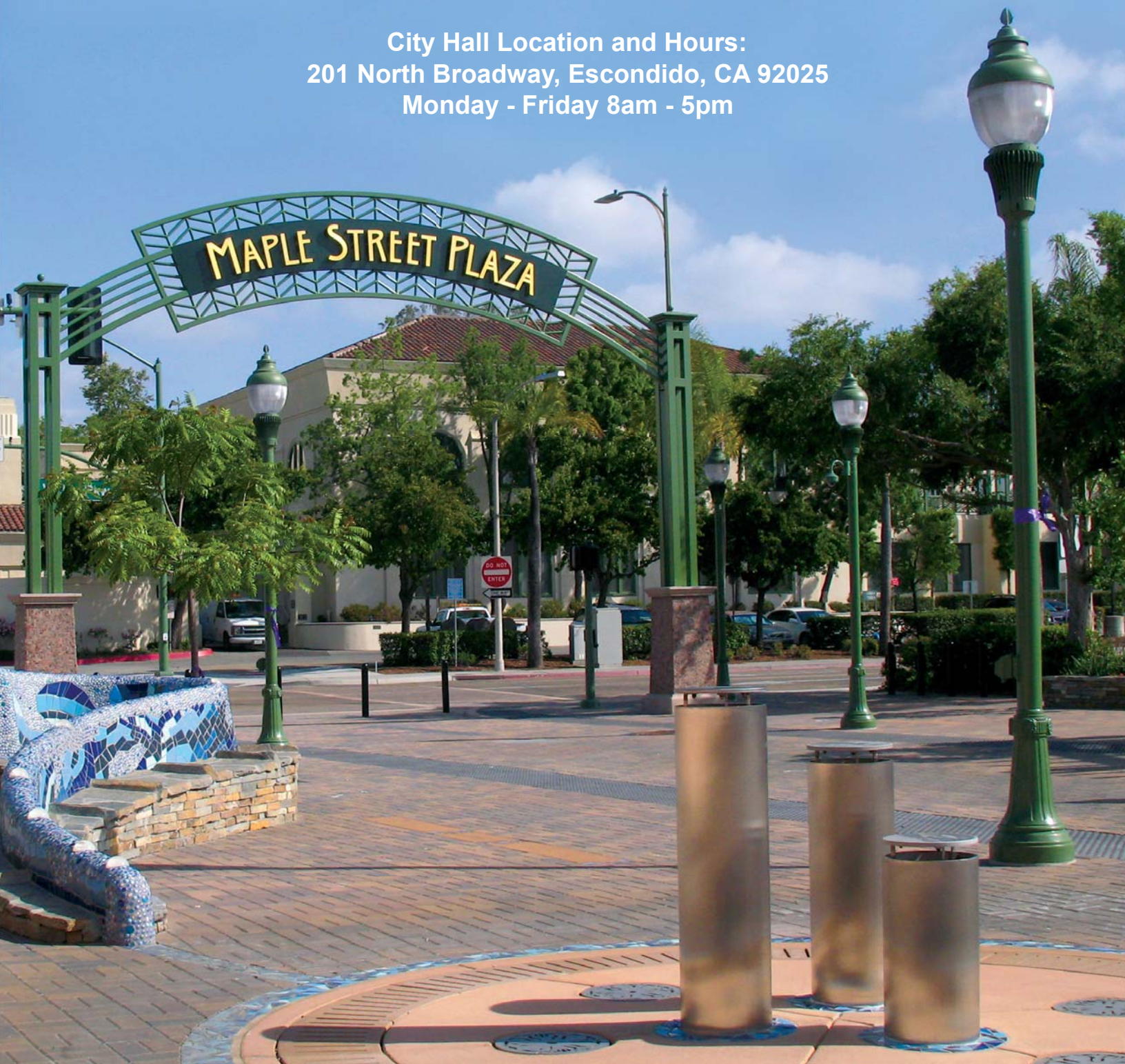
Android Users
