INFORMATION

Registration Packet

The Registration Packet consists of the Summer Camp Grid and The Camper Information/Health Form. Packets are available on our website at www.sburlrecdept.com.

Mail-In: The Registration Packet must be used for mailing in. It must include the deposits or full payment. Mail to the Recreation Dept.- 575 Dorset Street.

In-Person: If you plan to register in person- print off the Camper Information/Health Form, fill it out and bring it in. We will help you with registration. If not you will be required to fill out the form at the office.

On-Line: You can register on-line for camps, but you must print off the Camper Information/Health Form and return it to the Recreation Office by June 7, 2013. The form is also available on our website.

Camper information forms are copied and sent to each camp that your child will be attending this summer.

Camp Payment Policy

This Policy is specific for all Summer Camps. A Non-Refundable \$25.00 deposit per child, per camp, per session must be paid at the time of registration to be processed. If registering in person- we accept cash, checks or credit cards- MasterCard and Visa. If mailing in, send checks, payable to SBRD.

If registering On-Line, payment must be made in full at the time of the on-line registration with a Visa or MasterCard. There is a 2.8% + .90 site fee for on-line registration. This is paid directly to the processor- Xpress Pay.

For those paying the deposits- Regular payments or paying off the remaining balance may be made at any time prior to June 7, 2013. All final balances must be paid in full on or before June 7, 2013 for your child to remain enrolled. Any registration after June 7, 2013 must be paid in full at the time of any type of registration process.

Camp Refund Policy

This Policy is specific for all Summer Camps. We reserve the right to cancel or consolidate any camps which do not meet the minimum participation required. The deposit and a full refund will be issued if we cancel any camp.

If a participant cancels out of a camp or a session prior to seven days before the start date of that camp or session, a refund, less the \$25 Non-Refundable Deposit per child, per camp, per session will be given. Any time after that no refund is given. If there is an outstanding balance, the refund will be automatically applied to that balance and any remainder will be refunded. Refund checks take approximately three weeks to process.

Camper Information/Health Form

All Campers must have on file, with the Recreation Office, a 2013 Camper Information/Health Form. Only one form per child for the summer is needed. The form is sent to all camps that your child will be attending this Summer. Completed forms must be turned in prior to June 7, 2013. Forms are available on page 11 & 12, at the Recreation Office or on our website at www.sburlrecdept.com

Payment Schedule

\$25 Non-Refundable Deposit per child, per camp, per session, must accompany registration to be processed.

You can pay Weekly, Monthly or at any time prior to June 7, 2013.

Get an Hour for FREE!

Buy Two half day camps and Get the hour between FREE! Register your child for any morning camp and any afternoon camp in the same week, at the SB Middle and/or High School, that meets from 8:30a-12:00p and 1:00-4:00p, and get the hour of 12:00-1:00pm for FREE! We will watch your child during the lunch hour, and take them to their next camp.

Half day camps and REC Jr. or Teen Camp. Buy a half day camp and finish off your child's day at Jr. REC or Teen REC Camp. Half day camp has to be at the SB Middle or High School, and has to meet from 8:30a-12:00p or 1:00-4:00p. We will get your child from camp to the REC Day Camps or from REC Day Camps to their half day camp.

Extended Camp Options

Some Adventure Camps, Sports Camps, Specialty Camps and Technology Camps are eligible for Extended Camp Options. You will be asked during registration if the camps you are registering for have these options.

TIPS TO PARENTS

Daily Items to Pack

All items must be packed into a Backpack, so that your child may carry it to and from camp and during the day.

Sunscreen & Hat	Water Bottle
Rain Jacket or Poncho	Swimsuit & Towel
Water Shoes/Sandals	Extra set clothing
Morning and afternoon Snacks	
Lunch and drinks, if your child is attending an all day camp or one that is through the lunch hour.	

Daily Dress

All campers must dress appropriately to be active throughout the day and for the weather conditions. Proper clothing needs to be worn and packed each day for the camp that your child is attending.

Proper Footwear: are shoes that stay securely on the feet and protect the toes (i.e. sneakers). Children are not allowed to wear sandals, crocs, clogs, jelly shoes or any other type that doesn't protect or stay securely on. These are not safe for the activities that are conducted. Campers are required to wear a water type shoe for any water type activities. (i.e. Water specific shoe or sandals).

Lunch and Snacks

Lunch and Snacks must be non-perishable, no refrigeration is available. They should be packed into small coolers or lunch bags that contain ice packs. All Lunch bags or coolers must be labeled with your child's name.

Labeling Clothing

It is very important that all personal items and clothing be marked with your child's name with permanent ink or labels. The South Burlington Recreation & Parks Department is not responsible for lost, misplaced, or stolen items.

Lost & Found

All lost and found items will be displayed at the end of each day and at the end of a camp session. Please be sure to check for lost and found items daily. At the end of the summer all lost and found items will be kept at the Recreation Department until the end of the Fall season, at that time all items are donated to a local charity.

Don't Pack

Valuables, Electronics, Games or Toys- Do not send or allow your child to bring any of these to camp. The camp environment and program is not the place for such items. See the list of "What not to bring to Camp".

Sunscreen

Parents should apply sunscreen to their children prior to coming to camp. This will help us to insure that everyone has it on and we will encourage children to reapply throughout the day. Remember, cloudy days can be just as bad if not worse than sunny days. Sunscreen should be applied and packed everyday.

R.E.C. DAY CAMPS

Recreational Experiences for Children

Our R.E.C. Camps provide campers full or half day camp options during the Summer, as well as a daily option; Monday- Friday. Campers may attend one, or up to five days in a week, as well as mix and match their week with full and half day options. Register for one of our other half day camps in sports, specialty or technology and fill the day with a REC Camp. All REC Camps operate from 7:30am- 5:30pm, there is no early or late options. Drop off is from 7:30-8:30am and pick-up is from 4:30-5:30pm. REC Camp activities take place from 8:30am- 4:30pm. (half day options- pick up and drop off is at 12:30pm). Children attending all day or mornings need to bring a daily lunch. Afternoon Campers should eat lunch before they arrive. Lunch will be from 12:00-12:20pm each day. There will be 8-one week sessions from June 24- Aug. 16, and the daily fee includes all camp activities. See prices below for the full day and half day options. There is no camp on July 4th. Our staff is collage age and above with experience working with children. Teens who have completed our CIT Program are eligible as Jr. Counselors in our camps- 16 years of age and older.



Lil'Tykes R.E.C. Camp

Coed, Ages 3-4 yrs.

Lil'Tykes REC Camp provides 3 & 4 year olds the opportunity to socialize and play cooperatively with other children their age. (*Campers must be 3 by June 1, 2013 and potty trained*). Campers will participate in group games, arts & crafts, and exploring the outdoors through fun activities. Each day includes group time and games, free play indoors and out, and a variety of themed activities. This Summer campers have the option of staying all day. There will be rest periods throughout the day for all campers to rejuvenate themselves. This is a great camp for your child's first day-camp experience. We have a 1:6 ratio of counselors to campers.

Jr. R.E.C. Camp

Coed, Completing Grades 1st-6th

Jr. REC Camp is a combination of our traditional day camp and playground program all in one. Children will have the opportunity to make new friends, learn new things, and have fun while at camp. It also provides flexibility for the family looking for partial or individual day options. Jr. REC Camp is an activity-based camp with daily activities offered by our counselors, with the traditional activities of day camp thrown in; flag raising, skits, songs, Ultimates and all-camp activities. Campers are able to make choices of activities. Weekly field trips to the beach are offered as part of this camp. We have a 1:10 ratio of counselors to campers.

KinderKids R.E.C. Camp

Coed, Ages 5-6 yrs.

KinderKids REC Camp provides 5 & 6 year olds a great opportunity to have a more structured and age-specific camp. Each day campers will participate in group games, arts & crafts, and indoor and outdoor play. Children will have the opportunity to play cooperatively together and interact with children their own age. Central School provides a great space to hold this camp, with the playground structures and smaller spaces to play in. There will be a quiet period after lunch for campers to rejuvenate and be ready for an afternoon of fun! We have a 1:8 ratio of counselors to campers.

Teen R.E.C. Camp is it's own camp with their own counselors. The emphasis in this camp is Teen Leadership. The camp will prepare teens in teamwork and leadership. It is a great first step to future work with younger children. A large part of their day will be engaged in leadership activities and camp programs for teens. They will also interact with the Jr. REC Camp for special activities, trips and testing their leadership skills with younger campers. Campers who attend this camp should be serious about working on leadership. We have a 1:12 ratio of counselors to campers.
