





Cancellation of classes/programs will be at the discretion of Community Ed. If a class/ program is cancelled due to low enrollment, participants will be notified and receive a full refund. Customer-initiated cancellations made at least three business days prior to start of class or program may qualify for a refund minus a 5% processing fee. Customer-initiated cancellations made two or less business days prior to start of class/program or prior to second meeting of class/program with multiple meeting dates may qualify for a 50% refund. No refunds will be made following the second meeting of class/ program. Adventure Club, Trek and Travel and Early Childhood programs may have separate cancellation policies.
