AGES

Camps are based on grade levels instead of ages. Please enroll your child by the grade they will be attending in the fall 2012. Age groups vary from camp to camp. We try to offer each class to an appropriate age group(s) based on curriculum and past enrollment. Not every camp is offered to all age groups. Please keep in mind, Rose State College reserves the right to combine age groups based on enrollment. However, safety will always be considered with all ages.

CLASSROOM LOCATIONS

Our Kids College camps are held in various buildings on campus and at Traub Elementary. All children enrolled in a Kids College camp need to be dropped off and picked up in the cafeteria at Traub Elementary. If your child is enrolled in one of the Mid-Del Technology Center classes, please drop them off and pick them up at that location.

LUNCHES AND BREAKS

Campers are responsible for their own food. Campers must bring their own sack lunch with their name on the outside of the sack/container. Each instructor will utilize break times as needed throughout the day and we encourage parents to pack snacks for their children, during these breaks.

SUPPLY LISTS

DROPPING A COURSE

To withdraw from a course and receive a full refund, you must complete a withdrawal form, in person, at Tom Steed Community Learning Center before the start of the second class. No refunds will be issued after the second class meeting.

RECEIVING YOUR REFUND

Credit card and any reimbursements will post back to your account within 4-6 weeks. To receive a refund from the State of Oklahoma, the student's social security number is required. However, it is not required for credit card reimbursements.

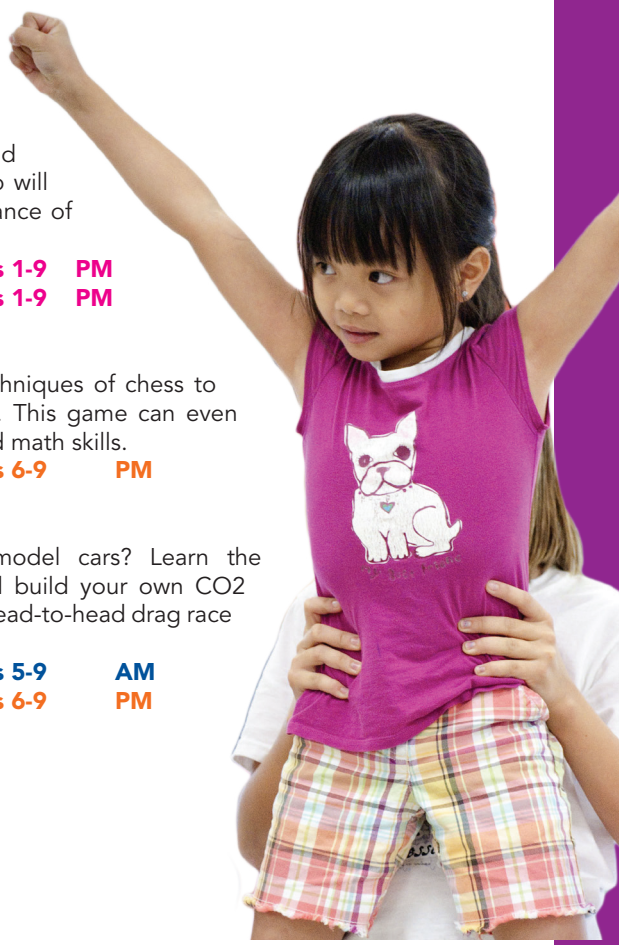

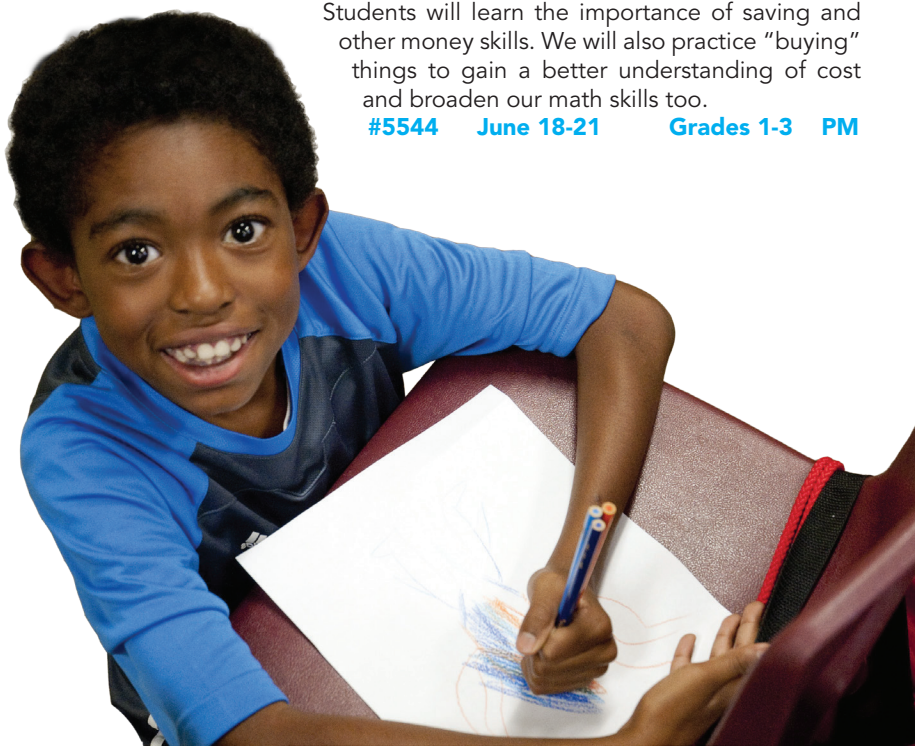

LEARN TO SWIM

LEARN TO SWIM LEVELS

To ensure your child's proper placement, carefully review the class levels. If you are unsure about the placement, enroll your child in the lower level. Children who have had more than a three month break from swimming should repeat the previous level as a refresher course. Children registered for an inappropriate class level are not guaranteed a transfer because the correct level may be full. Children will be tested on the first days, and the Aquatic Center Staff will assist you if you are unsure.

PARENT/TOT – A water adjustment class designed for children 18 months to 3 years old, accompanied by a parent in the water.

PRE-SCHOOL – (Ages 3-5) Introductory class will teach students water orientation, breath holding, floating comfortably, and basic techniques for front and back crawl. Aspects of Pre-School Level 1-3 will be taught.

BEGINNER – (Ages 6-12) Introductory class will teach students water orientation, breath holding, floating comfortably, and techniques for front and back crawl. Aspects of both Levels 1 & 2 will be taught.

ADVANCED BEGINNER – (Ages 6-12) Children must be able to swim five yards front and back crawl independently. Students will be introduced to the elementary backstroke, breaststroke, and rotary breathing. Aspect of Level 3 will be instructed.

INTERMEDIATE – (Ages 6-12) Children must be able to swim 10 yards front and back crawl and elementary back stroke. Students will be introduced to breaststroke, sidestroke, butterfly, diving, and deep water. Students will improve their technique on front and back crawl, learn rotary breathing, and increase strength and endurance. Aspects of both levels 4 & 5 will be instructed.

ADVANCED – (Ages 6-12) Children must be able to successfully complete the Intermediate skills test. Students will improve strokes and endurance, and be introduced to competitive swimming components and personal water safety.

JR. LIFEGUARD

Does your child swim like a fish? Enroll them in this exciting Kids College class that teaches the basics of Red Cross Lifeguarding and prepares the students for potential lifeguard certification. This class will be taught by certified Rose State College Lifeguards.
