



P - Scholarship Information

Families who have an income that would qualify them for the free or reduced price meal program may receive a 50 percent reduction in class fees up to \$25 per child, per brochure. Classes marked with **P** are not eligible for scholarships. Families may call Community Education at 507-328-4000 to determine if they meet the criteria.

Attendance by Non - Registered Children

For the safety and quality of the program, only children registered for the class may attend. Siblings and other children will not be allowed in the class.

Refund Policy

If you withdraw from a class 1 week or more before the start date, you will receive a refund minus a \$5.00 processing fee.

If you withdraw from a class less than 1 week before the start date, you will receive a pro-rated refund minus any costs incurred, including a \$5.00 processing fee.

If you withdraw from a class ON/AFTER the class start date: If you need to withdraw from a class

that meets three times or more after the class start date, you will need to contact the main office at 328-4000 to discuss the possibility of a refund. These are handled on a case-by-case basis.

Inclement Weather Policy

If Rochester Public Schools are cancelled for the day, all Community Education day and evening classes are cancelled. If school begins late, Community Education morning classes will not meet.
