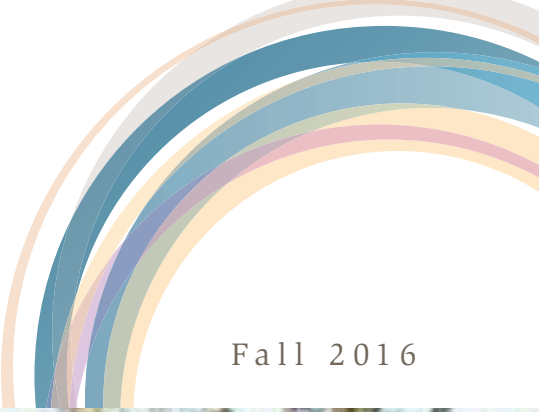

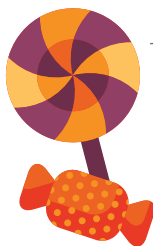

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

Fall 2016 Hikes | Saturdays, 9 am to noon (sign-in at 8:30 am)

September 3

San Dieguito Lagoon Trail/Del Mar

6.5 miles/150' of elevation gain

Enjoy views of San Dieguito River and tidal marshes; good bird viewing. We'll hike east to El Camino Real, where we'll turn around and walk all the way to the coast. Dogs allowed on leash. A one- to two-mile interpretive walk will also be offered.

Meeting location: From Via De La Valle just east of I-5, turn south on San Andres Drive. 32 58.769 N 117 14.847 W

October 1

Las Posas Park/2nd San Diego Aqueduct/Blue Bird Canyon/ Lake Wohlford Flume

7.0 miles/580' of elevation gain

Explore the 2nd San Diego Aqueduct north from Las Posas Road to Buena Creek Road and then head east along the Lake Wohlford Flume that transports water from Lake Wohlford to the Pechstein Reservoir at Blue Bird Canyon Road.

November 5

Frank's Peak and Mt. Whitney

6.2 miles/962' of elevation gain

Climb to the top of Mt. Whitney, the highest point in the City of San Marcos, and enjoy breathtaking 360-degree views.

December 3

Leo Carrillo Ranch and Simmons Family Park

5.3 miles/654' of elevation gain

The more challenging five-mile hike to Simmons Family Park will give hikers the opportunity to explore the Leo Carrillo Ranch Historic Park. **Please note: DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT LEO CARILLO PARK!** A shorter, four-mile hike will allow hikers to explore the trails of the Rancho Dorado/Rancho Carrillo area and visit Leo Carrillo Ranch Historic Park.

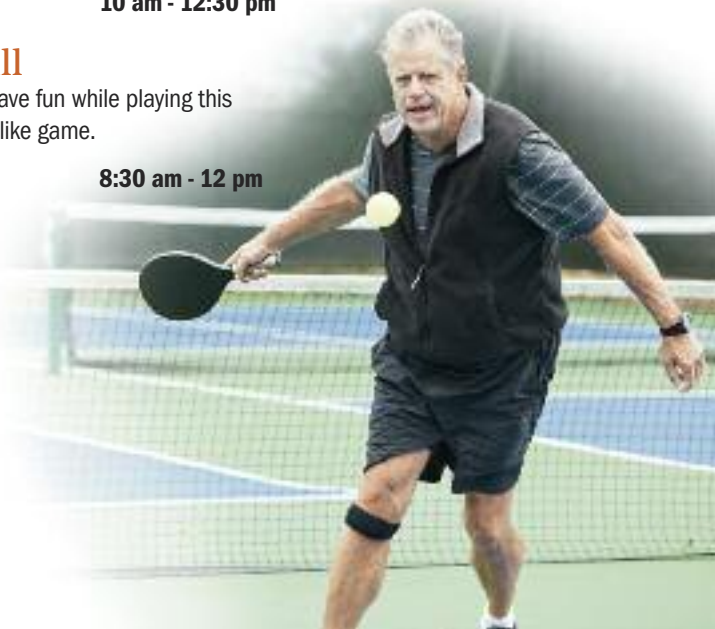

Dogs required to be on-leash elsewhere

San Marcos is home to four dog parks located at:

- **San Elijo Park**, 1105 Elfin Forest Road

- **Montiel Park**, 2290 Montiel Road
- **Sunset Park**, 909 Puesta del Sol

These parks provide a safe place for four-legged family members to run and play; however, dogs may only be off-leash in these designated areas. Leashes must be used when walking dogs on trails or in parks.

“Safety is our main concern,” explained Community Services Director Buck Martin. “Dogs that run free in parks and on trails may encounter rattlesnakes, opossum, mountain lions or poison oak.”

Keeping your dog on-leash in parks and on trails also prevents disturbance of wildlife in habitat areas and limits personal liability.

Perhaps most importantly, it is the law and dog owners may be cited for not complying.

Groups with less than 50 people are encouraged to make reservations in order to secure picnic shelters. Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance and are available to resident and non-resident groups and nonprofit organizations during normal park hours. Group areas can accommodate from 50 to 200 people. Fees are based on a two-hour minimum. Additional time may be reserved in one-hour increments. Additional fees apply for groups larger than 50.

Reservations do not include exclusive use of any other park amenities, including sports fields. Sports field reservations must be made through staff at the Corky Smith Gymnasium.
