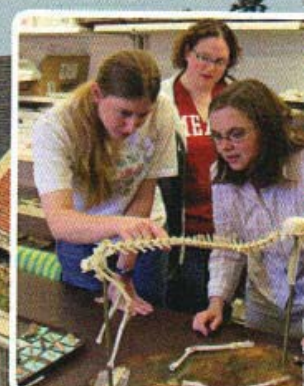
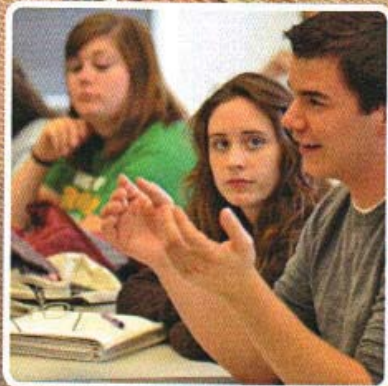

**Wide Selection of Courses:** Over 140 graduate and undergraduate courses are available in six different sessions, ranging from 3 to 12 weeks in length.

**Accessible to All:** Courses are offered on the Potsdam campus, at Jefferson Community College in Watertown, and online.

**On-Campus Housing and Meal Plans:** Convenient and affordable housing and meal plans are available on the Potsdam campus.

**Affordable Tuition Rates:** \$257 per undergraduate credit and \$432 per graduate credit for New York state residents. Tuition and fee charges are subject to change by the SUNY Board of Trustees.

### Billing Information for Summer Session Classes

- Students will be billed by the Student Accounts Office
- Email billing notifications will be sent out weekly to the student's Potsdam email account.
- Bills will be due by May 20, 2015 – the day prior to the first day of the summer session term. A student bill considered unpaid as of that date and may have registration cancelled.
- All certified Financial Aid will be posted as a deferred credit on the bill once it is processed.
- All students who wish to register on May 21, 2015 and after for the current and future sessions must go through the Office of Extended Education or Center for Graduate Studies and verify the courses are still available and then will be directed to the Student Accounts Office to pre-pay their bill. If using financial aid, the student must provide a completed Summer 2015 Financial Aid application to the registering office to avoid payment at the time of registration.
- All balances not paid in full by the billing deadline will have an "AS" hold placed on their account and will incur a late charge.

## GRADUATE STUDENTS

- Matriculated Graduate Students pay graduate tuition for all courses taken whether undergraduate or graduate level.
