Notary Class: This course exceeds the State of California qualifications for new applicants and for notaries that are renewing their commissions. *Commissioned notaries may take this course six months prior to their commission expiration date.* Students completing the class will receive a State-approved Certificate of Completion required to take the State-proctored notary examination. The State of California will offer a same-day exam (additional cost). \$45 materials fee payable in class.

Dropping a Class






* Student Parking:
