Accordingly, I hereby release the Parkway and Rockwood School Districts, together with their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages arising out of my participation in the Program; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability agreement I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim released in this agreement, I will indemnify and hold harmless each entity and person released herein from any and all litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur as the result of such claim.
4. Acknowledge that from time to time, Community Ed employee/designee may photograph or videotape myself while I am involved in a Community Education program or activity. These photographs or videotape will solely be used by Community Ed for the promotion and marketing of district programs/activities and will not be sold. 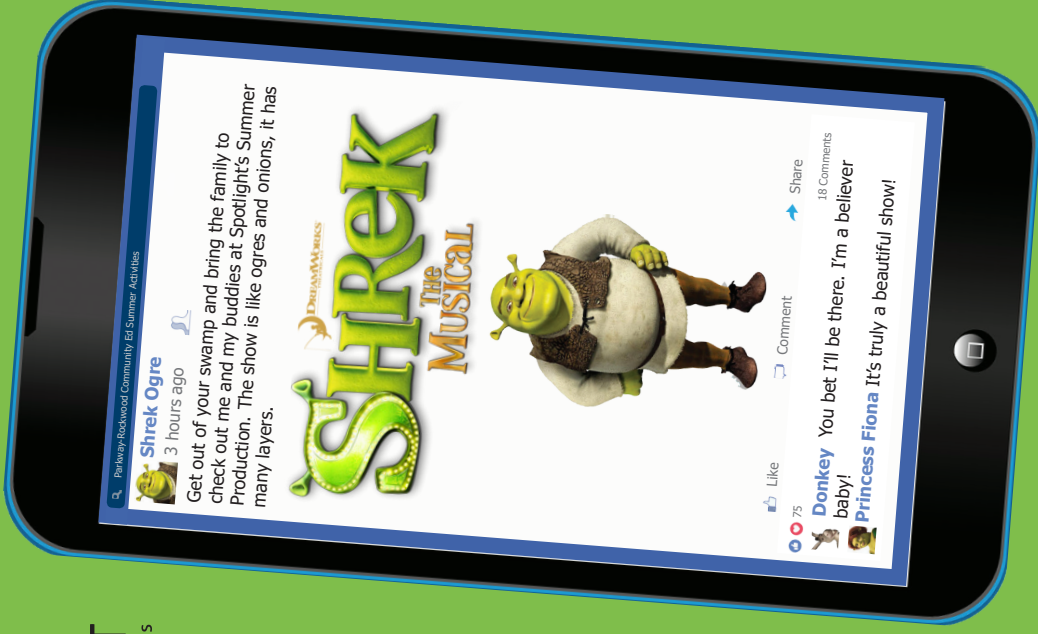
