Dear Waukeee Community Members,

Bring on the sun and warmer weather! As winter begins to change into spring, we look back on a VERY busy winter season for Community Education. All of our operations continue to show growth. We have had over 775 registrations for student and adult classes, which is a 73% increase from the previous winter. 40% of our high school students are now participating in the Silver Cord volunteer program. That equates to 462 high school students that are giving back to our community. Over 7,800 hours of facility space were scheduled for school district and non-school district reservations. Our facility supervisors logged in over 2,400 hours of supervision in keeping our buildings safe and secure. Child Care Services served 418 total students and children through our Beyond the Bell and Wee Warriors programs. We continue to provide wonderful opportunities for all ages to **Learn, Serve, and Thrive** in Waukeee!

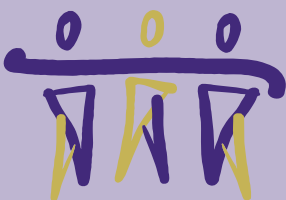
