Infants 2 and under are free with a paid adult. Youth under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a paid adult. To receive the resident rate, Munster and Highland residents must show ID. Students will be asked for their student ID.

Bathing Attire/Flotation Devices

Bathing suits are required for swimming in Munster Community Pool. Shorts are not considered acceptable bathing attire. Flotation devices (ie. life rings, noodles, inflatable tubes) are not allowed. Only coast guard approved life vests (no suits with built-in flotation) are allowed. We offer complementary use of life vests to our pool patrons thanks to a generous donation from **Munster Community Hospital**. Life vests can be checked out at the pool in exchange for your ID.

Adult Open Swim-Sundays from 11:45-12:45 pm

FREE to season pass holders only, during the regular season (ends 8/12/18). Must be at least 18 years old. Pickup your special pass at the Park Office. Must show Drivers License or ID upon entry. **Please be aware that private lessons could be scheduled during this time. If private rentals occur, we will make every attempt to inform you in advance.*

Other relatives, may not be included on the family membership. Passes are per individual and cannot be shared.

Parties must be scheduled (5) days in advance. A (3) day notice must be given to reschedule. A rescheduling fee of \$10 will be charged. If the pool is closed due to inclement weather, the party can be rescheduled at no additional charge. The rental fee is non-refundable if the party is cancelled. One adult per 10 children is required.

AMERICAN RED CROSS Swim Lesson Descriptions

30 minutes sessions w/ suggested ages:

Parent/Tot 6 months to 3 years

Skills worked on in this level include: guided parent interaction, rolling over, getting child comfortable on front and back, kicks, arm movements, submersion, and blowing bubbles through songs and games.

Preschool 3-5 years

Skills worked on in this level include: blowing bubbles: putting their face in the water, front and back floats, reach and pull for further stroke development, and simultaneous arm and leg motion.

Youth 6+ years

Allow our swim director to assign your child in a level that will meet and challenge their ability level to get them to be the best swimmer possible!

Lightning Warning System

Munster Parks and Recreation uses a lightning warning system in our parks. The signal is activated by threatening weather. You will hear an audible siren horn and see a flashing light on top of the device (typically located on shelter roofs) in the park. When the warning signal activates, all patrons must SEEK SHELTER IMMEDIATELY. One your hear three horn signals, park activities can resume. This system is not fail-proof. Take shelter immediately when lightning threatens even if a signal has not sounded.

Refund Policy

Munster Parks and Recreation is committed to providing the highest quality recreation activities, events, and programs. If a person is not completely satisfied with a program or service due to circumstances under the department's control, Munster Parks and Recreation will arrange for the person to repeat the class at no charge, use the fee for another class during the same season, or receive a refund.

A Full Refund Will Be Granted . . .

- 1. If a participant is dissatisfied with a Munster Parks and Recreation class, program or activity due to circumstances under the department's control. Refund requests must be made prior to the midpoint of the class, program or activity.
- If the refund is initiated by Munster Parks and Recreation (i.e. cancelled class, low enrollment).
- 3. For injury or illness, with a doctor's note. (Once a program has begun, only a prorated fee for classes met will be charged).
- 4. On Trips or Shows if the seat can be resold or if Munster Parks and Recreation cancels the trip or show.

All Other Refunds (unless otherwise noted)

- Refunds will be issued prior to the start of a program if the program enrollment is greater than the minimum, minus a \$10 service charge per program plus the cost of supplies (if applicable).
- 2. After the start of the program, no refund will be issued except for illness/injury, accompanied by a doctor's note.

Refunds will not be granted for the

following: schedule conflicts, vacations, special events, tickets, coupons, field reservations, facility rental fees and other reasons beyond our department's control.

Refunds are processed weekly on Monday and checks are mailed on Thursday. You can contact the Park Department to get the latest status on your refund.

Refund Policy Other Vendors

Several of our programs require payment to be made directly to the vendor, which we will accept at the Park Office. However, those organizations have their own refund policies. Policies will be available at the Park Office and can be requested at time of registration.

Register Early

Often times participants will wait until the last minute to register for a program. Disappointment occurs because a program has been filled or possibly cancelled due to low enrollment. Ensure yourself a spot and help keep our programs running by registering early.

24-Hour Hotline

Credit Cards

The Town of Munster accepts all major credit cards.

Lightning Prediction and Warning System

The Thorguard Lightning Prediction System was installed in the parks to warn patrons of the danger of lightning. When the 15-second warning horn sounds you should:

- 1. Clear the park immediately or seek proper shelter.
- Do not return to the park or move out of the area until short horn blasts sound. This is the "all clear sound."
- If the all clear sound does not sound after 30 minutes, dangerous weather is still in the area and the activity should be cancelled. Stop and seek shelter anytime you believe lightning threatens you, even if a signal has not been sounded.

The system is active April 1 - November 1
