

GEORGETOWN FOODIE TOUR

Thursday, September 13, 2018 9 a.m.—7 p.m. Long before the Kennedy family made this neighborhood of high-end retail and fashion popular, **Georgetown** was a working-class port city that predated the federal city of Washington, D.C. Its roots are still very much alive and can be seen in the red brick town homes and turn-of-the-century factories that are found throughout the area. This tour will bring together progressive, high-end cuisine, with long-standing D.C. institutions; restaurants and shops that were up and running before Prohibition, with swanky hotspots. We will depart Georgetown at approximately **5 p.m.**

Then it's on to the Old Republic Distillery, York County's first distillery since Prohibition. Learn how the company started, how they make premium spirits, and enjoy a tasting. We'll end the day at Turkey Hill Experience, where we'll get to make our very own flavor of ice cream! The coach will depart for home at approximately 4:30 p.m.

ST. MARY'S CITY, MD

Friday, October 26, 2018

7:30 a.m.-7 p.m.

Our first stop is **Solomons Island**, where we'll pick up our step-on guide for a short walking tour, including a stop at the historic Our Lady Star of the Sea for a brief talk. Lunch is at Boomerang's Restaurant, where we will enjoy a buffet lunch. After lunch, we will board the coach and travel to Historic St. Mary's City, the birthplace of Catholicism, and the site of the fourth permanent settlement in British North America. This was Maryland's first settlement and for 61 years (until 1695) its colonial capital. Colorful living history and amazing archaeology reveal the past at Maryland's first capital. Explore a colonial plantation, tall ship, a brick chapel and an Indian hamlet. Visitors can see archaeological excavations and experience hands-on history. This will be a self-guided tour with time to visit the gift shop. Our last stop will be at Godiah Spray Plantation with people in period costumes and "attitude." We will depart at 4:30 p.m.

COST: \$113. Includes coach, breakfast snack, admissions/tours, lunch, gratuities and host.

OLD TOWN ALEXANDRIA, VA

Tuesday, October 30, 2018

8:30 a.m.-6 p.m.

We'll meet our step-on guide at Market Square in Old Town Alexandria. The 11/2 hour driving tour will include the history, legends and folklore of Alexandria with a stop at Christ Church. Christ Church was the first Episcopal Church in Alexandria and has played an important role in the life of the city since its completion by John Carlyle in 1773. Lunch is at Gadsby's Tavern, where we'll enjoy our pre-selected Colonialinspired lunch. Gadsby's consists of two buildings, the ca. 1785 tavern and the 1792 City Hotel. Your choices for lunch are: Monte Cristo Virginia (puff pastry stuffed with Smithfield ham, smoked turkey and cheese with a fresh raspberry sauce); Chicken Salad (on grain bread with house-made potato salad), Ale Battered Codfish (topped with crispy onion rings, served with hand-cut fries, coleslaw and tartar sauce), or vegetarian option of seasonal ravioli (butternut squash, apple and goat cheese). All choices will be served with Tavern Salad, Sally Lunn Bread, English Trifle for dessert, soft drinks, coffee and tea. Please make selection when reserving space. After lunch, there will be some free time to explore and shop on your own before we depart at 4 p.m. COST: \$100. Includes coach, tour/guide, lunch, gratuities and host.

THE AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY/SPACE SHOW, NY

The museum is renowned for its exhibitions and scientific collections, which serve as a field

guide to the entire planet and present a panorama of the world's cultures. Our inclusive ticket will also gain us access to the **Space Show**: *Dark Universe* celebrates the pivotal discoveries that have led us to greater knowledge of the structure and history of the universe and our place in it—and to new frontiers for exploration. There will be time to explore on your own, to have lunch, and to visit the museum shop before we depart at **4 p.m.**

The National Museum of the American Indian celebrates the lifeways, languages, literature, history and art of Native Americans. Through its exhibitions, programs and publications, the museum presents the extraordinary achievements of the indigenous peoples of the Western Hemisphere. If you are a frequent traveler with CCBC, you may know that our regular coach driver, James, is Native American. He is a member of the Monacan Indian Tribe—a federally recognized nation. His father is full-blooded Lakota Sioux and his mother is Monacan Indian. He will be my co-host for the day and will talk about his Native American roots, and will lead us in the museum to where his family photos are on display. This is all self-guided and lunch will be on your own in the Mitsitam Café, offering meals and snacks based on the indigenous foods and culinary traditions of the Native Americans. We'll depart at 3:30 p.m. **COST:** \$60. Includes coach, gratuities, and host.
