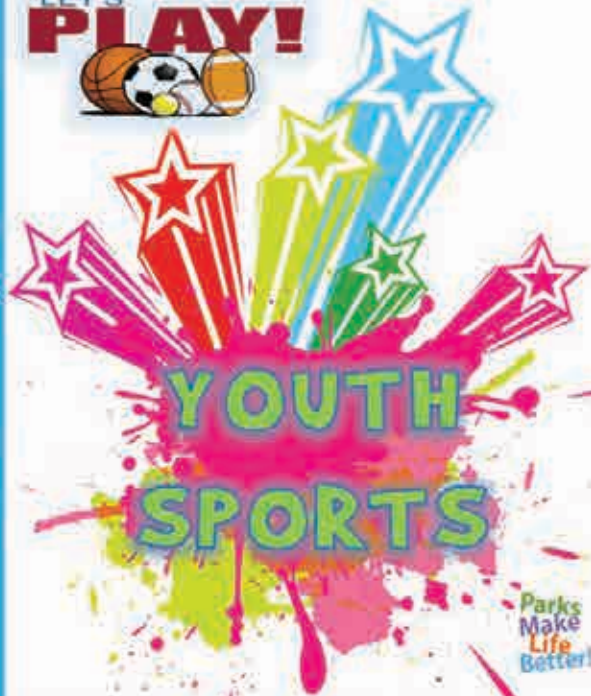

WELCOME SPRING WITH SPRINKLER SPRING CLEANING

Springtime means spring cleaning and big opportunities for water savings! By performing a Sprinkler Spring Cleaning, you can save water by fixing leaks, broken sprinkler heads and malfunctioning timers. Outdoor irrigation wastes the most water, so cleaning up outside will save you money and help conserve!

Sprinkler Spring Cleaning Checklist:

- Do a walk through:
 - Check for moss or discolored concrete (which may indicate excessive runoff)
 - Visually inspect valves to ensure they are operating properly
 - Inspect your hose and positive shut-off nozzle
 - Remember: nozzles are now required by local ordinance. Need a nozzle? Give us a call! 714-548-3690
- Check sprinkler heads:
 - Run each cycle separately to evaluate each sprinkler head
 - Replace broken, cracked, chipped or worn components
 - Adjust overspray with a screwdriver
- The sidewalk and street won't grow! So don't water it
- Check sprinkler timer:
 - Replace batteries/check power source is functioning properly
 - Check date and time is correct on timer. Make sure you're watering on the correct days

Watering days are maximums.
To help conserve, only water when your lawn needs it.

HOME ESCAPE PLAN

“Every second counts during a fire. Create and practice a home escape plan so you and your family can get out quickly if the smoke alarm sounds!”

Sadly, only 18 percent of families with children age 3-17 have practiced home fire drills.

Plan Ahead

- Make a home escape plan showing two ways out of every room. Discuss the plan with everyone in your home.
- Choose an outside meeting place in front of and a safe distance from your home.
- Practice your escape plan at least twice a year. During your drills, practice escaping from different exits. Teach children to escape on their own.
- Make sure someone is assigned to assist small children, older adults, or family members with disabilities.

Respond Safely if a Fire Occurs

- Smoke and heat rise, so “Stay Low and Go!” Crawl and follow your escape plan.
- Close doors as you evacuate to slow the spread of smoke and fire.
- Test doors before opening. Use the back of your hand to test for heat, starting at the bottom and working your way up. If the door feels warm, don’t open it. Use your secondary way out.
- Once you are outside, stay outside. Never go back inside for any reason.
- Call 9-1-1 for help once you are safely outside your home.

If Trapped By Fire

- Close the door between you and the fire.
- Use towels, blankets, or clothing to seal the cracks and help prevent smoke from entering the room.
- Call 9-1-1 and tell the dispatcher where you are in the home.
- Signal for help from a window when the firefighters arrive.

ORGANIC RECYCLING PROGRAM

The District's Organics Recycling program will begin in the Fall of 2018. The District's decision to provide an organics recycling program is pertinent now that Governor Brown signed AB 1594 into law which mandates that green waste used as Alternative Daily Cover (ADC) at landfills will no longer receive diversion credits effective January 1, 2020. State law requires local agencies to divert 50 percent of solid waste away from landfills. Many agencies will not meet the 50 percent mandate when ADC is no longer receiving diversion credits unless they find other means for disposing their green waste. As technology, disposal rates, and various regulations have changed, we are at the next stage of solid waste management. The new regulations will have economic and operational impacts on every community in California. Organic waste collected in MCSD's service area is taken to CR&R's Anaerobic Digestion (AD) Facility in Perris, CA. The anaerobic digester is a state of the art technology that will convert green waste and food scraps into renewable natural gas.

HOW THE NEW GREEN ORGANICS CONTAINER WILL WORK AND WHAT TO KNOW:

- Residents will need to separate their food scraps and yard waste into the NEW green organics container.
- Your current service day will NOT change.
- Carts should be placed at curbside or designated collection point, no later than 7:00 AM with the handles and wheels facing towards the curb.
- Please place carts side-by-side, approximately 1-foot apart and at least 3-feet from any obstruction (i.e. parked cars, trees, mailboxes, etc.)

WHAT MATERIALS AM I PLACING IN THE NEW ORGANIC CART?

From the YARD: Grass clippings, leaves, weeds, prunings, flowers, and other yard and garden waste.

From your KITCHEN: Fruit, bread, fish, meat, vegetables, dairy and FOG (fats, oil, and grease).

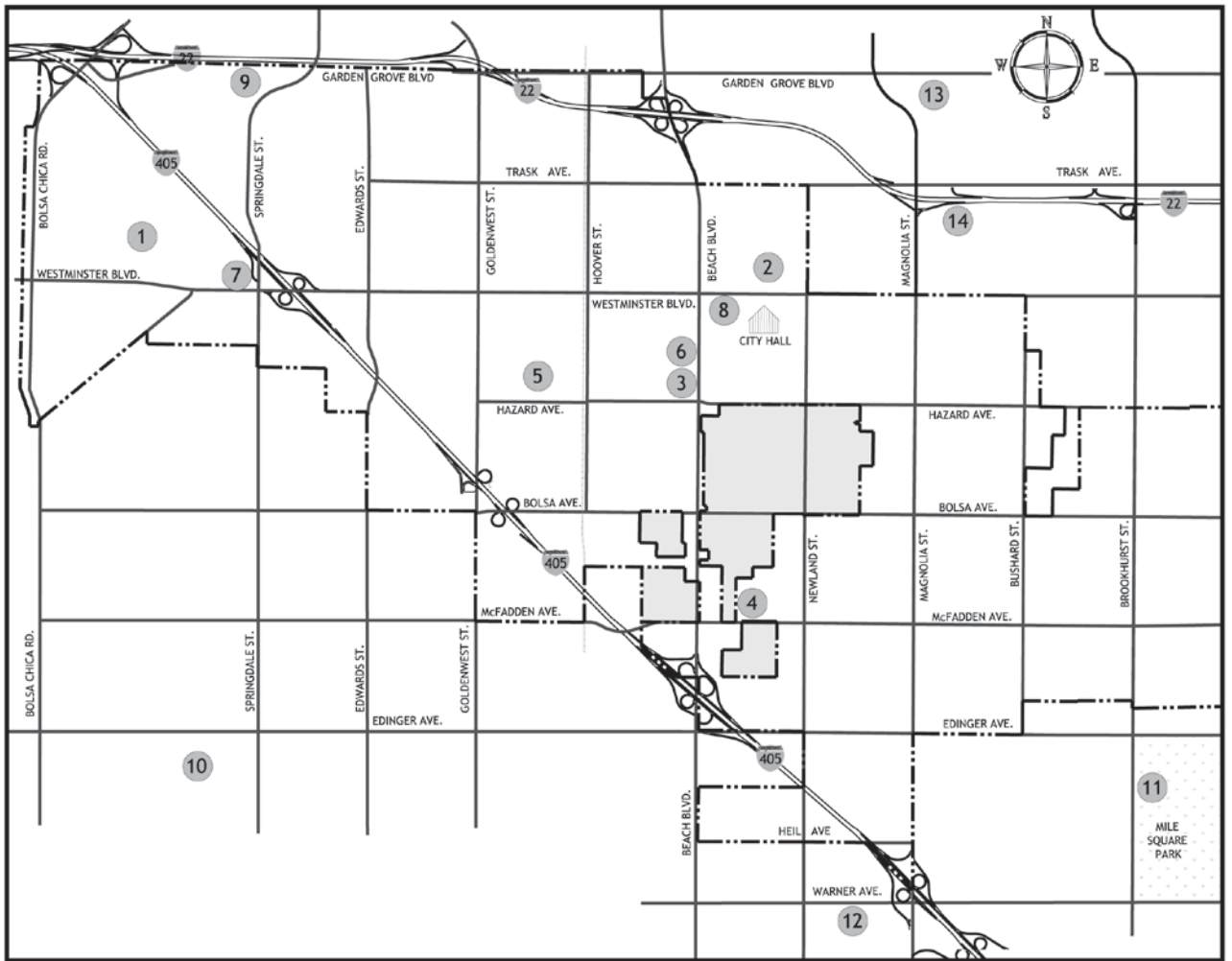
