



BODY SCULPTING/FITNESS

Body sculpting (or core conditioning) is a non-aerobic, muscle-toning class, usually focused on core strength. Most sculpting classes use weight bars, exercise bands, or dumbbells, or a combination of these gadgets. You perform traditional weight-training moves in a class setting.

What body sculpting and core conditioning does for you: Gives you strength, muscle tone and lowers your risk of bone loss, but only if you lift heavy enough weights.





MyCAA is the Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts program, offered by the Department of Defense. It allows military spouses to train for in-demand careers at little or no cost.

Each online program allows you to learn at your convenience and enables you to move your career wherever you are stationed.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Spouses of an active duty Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine service member in pay grades E1-E5, W1-W2, or O1-O2
- If your spouse is in the National Guard or is an AGR Member, they must be on federal Title 10 active duty orders.

Note: You must finish your program within 18 months of starting
